Barriers

Tuesday, May 14, 2019, Officers Dobosz and Bronowich will respond to OEM center (Kearny NJ) to retrieve five (5) trailers filled with traffic barriers. Those barriers will be stored at the Rec Center parking lot for pickup by DPW. On Monday, May 20, 2019, same Officers will return trailers back to Kearny.



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Signboards

Signboards will be stationed on Thursday, May 9, 2019 at the following locations which read, "Memorial Day Parade// Saturday May 19 12pm // Expect Road Closures".

At 11:40am, the signboards will be pre-programmed to read, "Road Closed" until the duration of the closure. Below are the locations of the boards:

Paterson Plank across from library Secaucus Library
Centre Ave @ 5th Street
Paterson Plank Rd @ Born Street

Department of Public Works

DPW will place the traffic barriers on the corners described in **Exhibit-A** on Friday, May 17, 2019. Empty trailers will be stored at the Rec Center parking lot. ~~DPW will pick up a pallet of cones (qty. 180) from NJDOT yard on Friday, May 17, 2019 and pre-position them where needed.~~ DPW will supply heavy-duty dump trucks and/or garbage trucks (qty. 5) and pre-position those trucks in strategic locations to be utilized as effective barriers. DPW Personnel will be responsible for moving trucks to and from their positions.

Parade Day

Officers assigned to the Traffic Division will enforce all parking restrictions. All vehicles in violation of parking restrictions will be impounded. (Town Ordinance: 127-41). Main will be on standby with two trucks at 10am.

Mailboxes and Garbage Cans

On Saturday, May 18, 2019, Officers from the Traffic Division will shrink wrap all garbage cans and mailboxes along the route. Officer Eccles will coordinate with the Post Master to wrap the mailboxes following the last pickup.

Traffic Division will position the traffic trailer with traffic control devices within the Santander Bank. Barriers and delineators will be positioned along the sidewalk on Paterson Plank Road near the intersection with Humboldt Street for crowd control during the parade.

Pedestrian Safety

Delineators will be placed along both sides of Paterson Plank Road beginning from Plaza Center Road north to the Gas Station and Noches De Columbia. Additional delineators will be placed along Plaza Center Road to cordon off the parade route. Yellow Caution tape will be placed between the delineators to create a barricade for spectators. Spreaders and cones will be used to supplement the barriers.

Hudson County Sheriff's Office

HCSO will be providing a K9 who will arrive at 10:00am. Officer Bronowich will conduct a sweep of the Buchmuller Park with K9 Officer utilizing the Pack-Eye Radiation Detector. Park Patrol will remain in the park thereafter.

EMS // OEM

One ambulance will be dedicated to this event. The ambulance will stage at the North End Lot and follow in the rear of the parade. They will ultimately stage at or near Buchmuller Park throughout the duration.

The Traffic Division personnel will be responsible for cleanup of traffic control devices and signboards following the conclusion of the event.

Buchmuller Park

The parade will end inside Buchmuller Park where there will be the traditional beer garden festival. Two (2) Officers will be posted directly at the beer garden and three (3) officers will remain posted within the limits of Buchmuller Park. All remaining Officers will be relieved by the Officer in Charge at the conclusion of the event.

Following the parade, all vehicles (except for Dunkin Donuts) will be moved to the Santander Bank.

Should personnel call out it shall be the responsibility of the communications officer to facilitate a replacement and inform the Officer-In-Charge.
